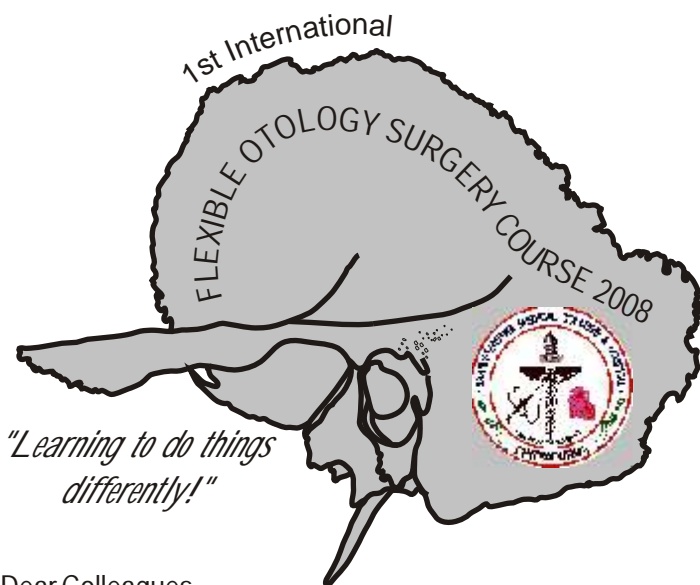

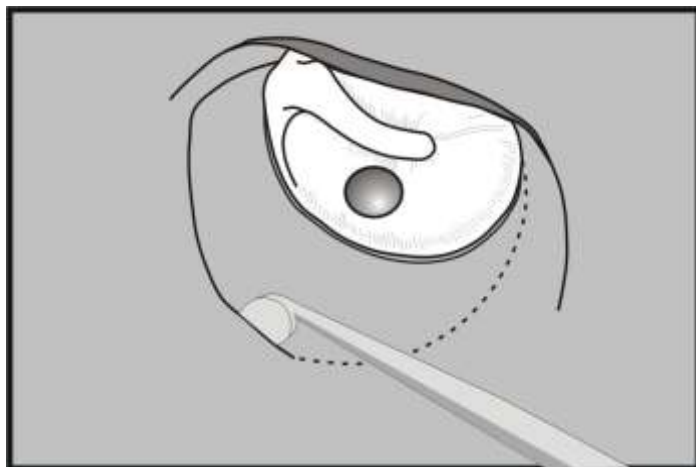

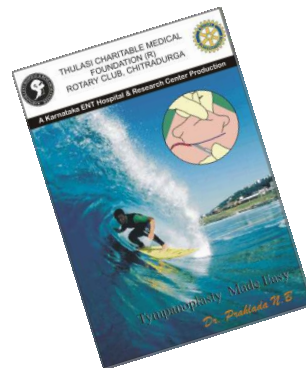

## About Chitradurga City



Located at a Distance of 202 kms. northwest of Bangalore, in the heart of the Deccan Plateau, Chitradurga is recognised as the land of valour and chivalry. The district headquarters town, Chitradurga owes its name to "Chitrakaladurga", or "Picturesque Castle". This is a massive fortress on the top of granite hills that rises dramatically from the ground (See pictures). Archaeological remains found in the area, trace its history to the 3rd Millennium BC.

A rock edict of Emperor Ashoka, near Brahmagiri reveals that Chitradurga was part of the Mauryan Empire during the rule of royal dynasties like the Rashtrakutas, Chalukyas and Hoysalas. But it really achieved eminence, as a feudal state of the Vijayanagar Empire, under the dynastic rule of the Nayakas or "Paleyagars", known for their heroic exploits. The most eminent of the feudatory chieftains, was Madakari Nayaka, who after the fall of the Vijayanagar Empire, declared his suzerainty and consolidated his power. This hill fortress built by the Nayakas during the Vijayanagar era, became their stronghold later. In 1777, the fort was captured by Hyder Ali, along with his son Tipu Sultan. After Tipu Sultan's defeat by the British, the fort came under the rule of the royal Mysore Family.

The picturesque remains of that historical splendor is still awaiting for your arrival.

## Rhinoplasty for Crooked Nose Deformity with Dorsal hump

22 Old year young was bitten by horse while training the horse. He developed perichondritis and was treated elsewhere for the same. He presented to us with Cauliflower ear as seen in the pre-operative picture. Shrunken cartilage was removed and grafted with autologous rib chondrograft. Helical margin loss and cicatrization was repaired with excision of scar tissue and post-aural pedicled skin flap. After 2 weeks pedicled flap was severed from its origin and was used to construct the auricular rim. Immediate post-op result is shown in the post-op picture.
